

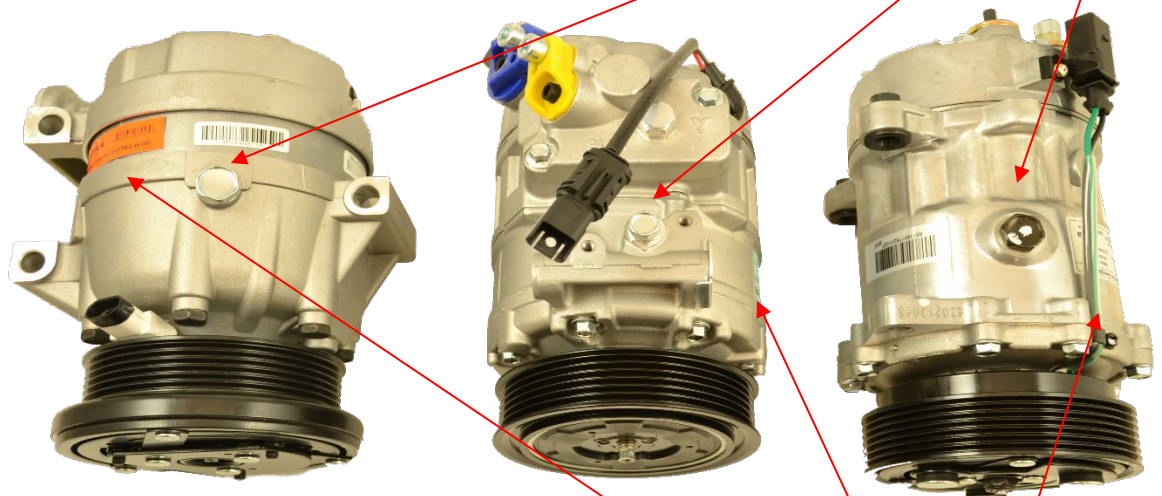
V-5, V-7, Sanden and 7SEU Style Compressor Oil Level Check

TECH TIP

In V-5, V-7, Sanden and 7SEU style compressors, the oil cannot be checked where the manifold lines attach to the compressor. In order to properly check the oil for the gpd replacement V-5, V-7, Sanden, 7SEU compressors, you must remove the oil fill bolt located on the compressor housing. This bolt is shown here in the photo below:



The proper amount of oil for the compressor can be found [here](#) on the side of the compressor. Please note that attempting to check the oil level from the manifold connection will not result in a correct measurement. The only way to properly check the oil is to drain the compressor completely through the oil fill bolt as shown above.
