
2007–2019 Nissan Compressor Wiring Harness Troubleshoot

THE PROBLEM

A common issue has been noted regarding the OE electrical connector/compressor pigtail on late model Nissan vehicles. The electrical connector (on the wiring harness side that plugs into the compressor) becomes loose after being separated and plugged back in. This electrical issue often leads to a malfunctioning A/C system.

THE SOLUTION

Thoroughly inspect the wiring harness connectors before installing. Make sure to inspect the terminal inside of the electrical connector. In some cases, the terminals
